Perdido Key Sediment Placement (preferred)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would reintroduce sand back into the barrier island system at Gulf Islands National Seashore by placing sediment dredged from Pensacola Pass onto the Gulf shoreline of the easternmost 2 miles of Perdido Key. This would partially restore injuries to barrier island habitat caused by the *Deepwater Horizon* oil spill. The National Park Service would work in close coordination with U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The U.S. Department of the Interior would be the Implementing Trustee for this project.


