Reducing Injury and Mortality of Bottlenose Dolphins in Florida from Illegal Feeding Activities (non-preferred)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would provide restoration benefits to Florida Gulf Coast bottlenose dolphins by reducing the number of injuries and mortalities due to illegal feeding. This project aims to reduce lethal impacts to dolphins from illegal feeding activities by effectively changing human behaviors through a targeted outreach and education campaign. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration would be the Implementing Trustee for this project.
