

Alabama Allocation of Restoration Funds






Values reflect Restoration Type allocations from DWH settlement. Earned interest is not included.

Funding Update




- Committed approximately \$184 million for projects and planning activities as of November 2023.
- The total settlement allocation is \$295 million (excluding earned interest).

Recent Activities

- Continued implementation of projects from Early Restoration; and Restoration Plans I, II, and III
- Approved continuation of restoration activities for the following projects which had funds remaining after the initial project period:
 - Enhancing Capacity for the Alabama
 Marine Mammal Stranding Network
 - Stewardship of Coastal Alabama
 Beach Nesting Bird Habitat



ALTIG Restoration Status



To date, the AL TIG has approved 48 projects:

- 4 projects Completed
- 9 projects in Operations and Maintenance/Monitoring and Adaptive Management phase
- 31 projects in Implementation
- 4 projects terminated



Bayfront Park Restoration and Improvements – Phases IIa and IIb


Approved In: Restoration Plan III

Project Budget: \$8,567,385

• **Project Status:** In Process

Project Updates:

- In-water work has been completed
- Upland construction work about to begin
- Anticipated completion date is Fall 2024





Dauphin Island Eco-tourism & Environmental Education Area

Approved In: Restoration Plan I

• **Project Budget:** \$2,238,613

Project Status: In Progress

Project Updates:

- 90% of the design work is complete
- Anticipate requesting bids for construction in the coming weeks
- Construction to begin in early 2024





Laguna Cove Little Lagoon Natural Resource Protection

Approved In: Restoration Plan I

• **Project Budget:** \$4,400,000

Project Status: In Progress

Project Updates:

- 100% of the design work is complete
- All National Historic Preservation Act approvals have been received
- Anticipate requesting bids for construction in the coming weeks
