PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project will construct a public boardwalk along the Jourdan River to provide recreational access to and information about this tidal estuarine ecosystem in coastal Mississippi.

The project will include a boardwalk, nature observatory, seating areas, and educational signage about the wetlands, coastal, and nearshore habitats including the tidal Jourdan River, adjacent estuarine marsh, and living resources (e.g., birds) that use these habitats.

This project will tie into the Phase 1 Noma Drive Public Access Improvements project, which will be implemented by the City of Diamondhead, using other funding which has already been secured. The Phase 1 Noma Drive Public Access Improvements project amenities include a public boardwalk, adjacent boat ramp, and public parking lot.
