



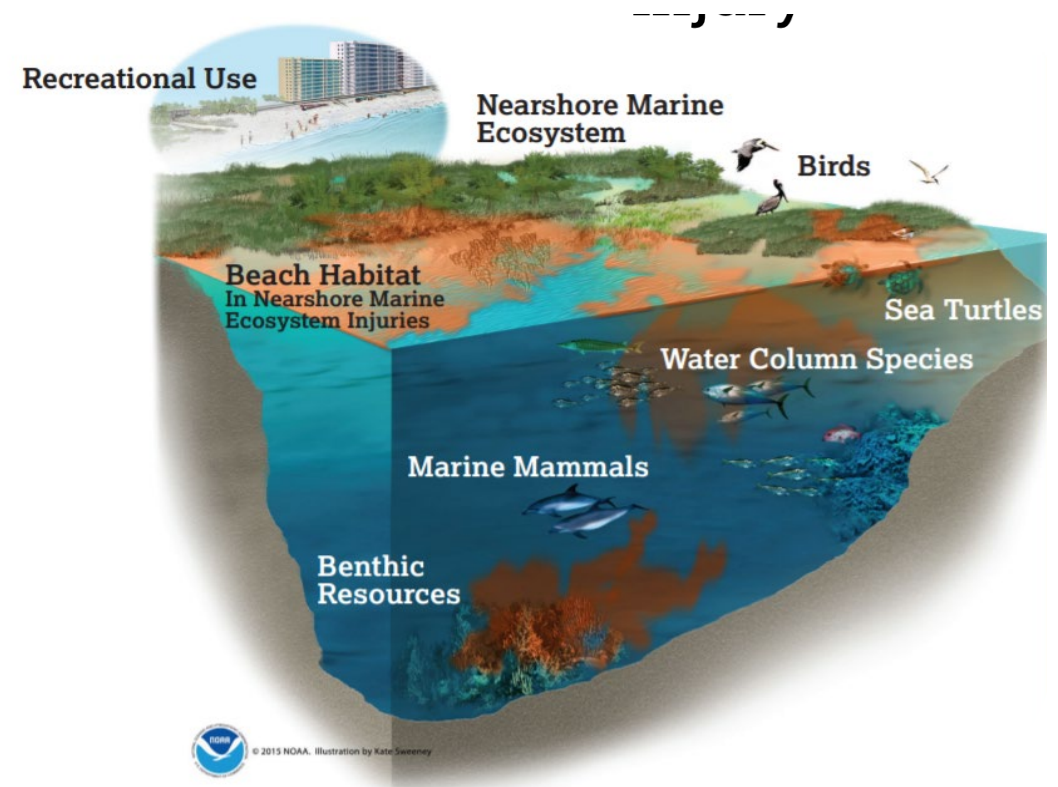

Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill



- In April 2010, the Deepwater Horizon exploded, caught fire, and sank
- Discharged 3.19 million barrels of oil into the Gulf over 87 days
- Injured wildlife, habitats, and ecological functions
- Adversely effected recreational opportunities
- Impacted shoreline and state waters of Louisiana, Alabama, Mississippi, Texas, and Florida and the open waters of the Gulf



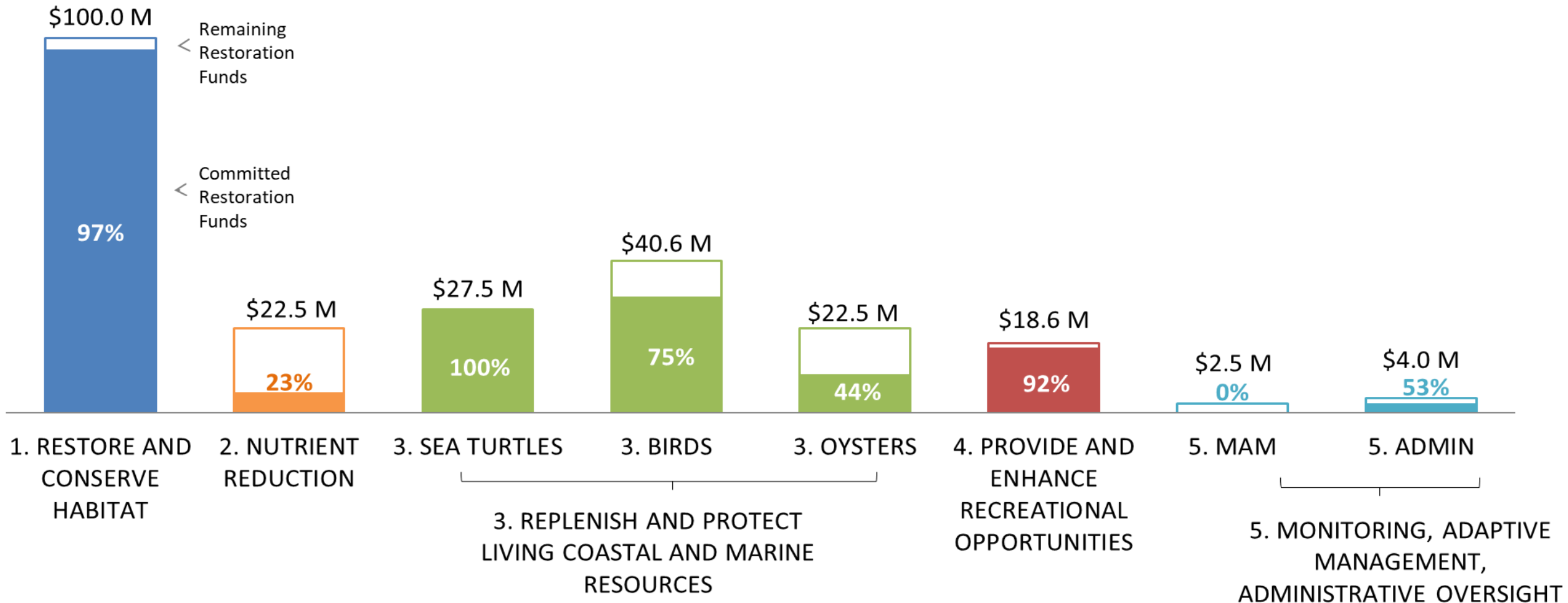

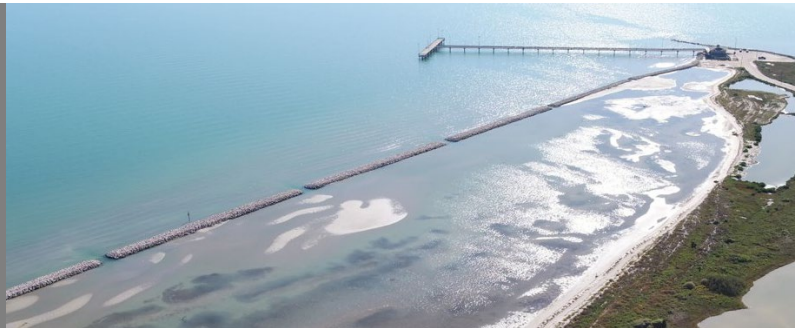

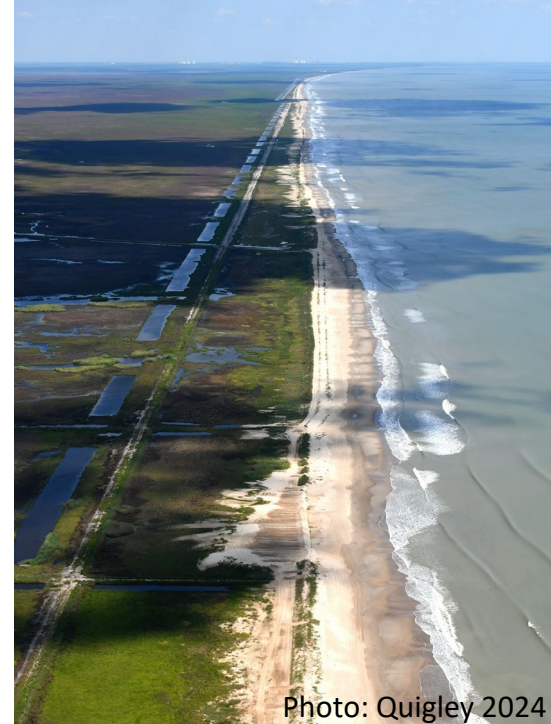
